

House Training Quick Tips

- * Remember that 98% of accidents in the house will be our fault.
- * Eyes on the puppy at all times - you can't correct what you don't see. Use the crate when you can't supervise.
- * Monitor water intake carefully - what goes in will come out. If you're having issues, don't leave water down all the time - give only at meal times. An 8 week old pup will have to go about 10 min. after a sip.
- * You puppies age in months = how many hours they can hold it during the day (ex. 3 month old dog can hold it for 3 hours) as long as they don't drink water. They can go longer overnight.
- * If you take your puppy outside and he doesn't pee, when you come inside he goes in the crate. Wait 10 - 30 minutes and try again. If he doesn't go, back in the create and wait another 10 - 20 min.
- * If you catch him peeing in the house make a load sound, pick him up and take him out. If he finishes outside throw a party for him.
- * If you find an accident and you didn't see it happen, it's your fault - you didn't supervise!
